

Tomatoes for hotter conditions

Almost all of our tomatoes can be grown outdoors or in a greenhouse, but there are some that are particularly suited to growing under glass. While growing tomatoes under glass can give you a bigger or earlier harvest, it does also come with its own set of challenges, which can vary dependent on your own specific growing environment. The varieties listed below are highly recommended for hotter conditions:

- Montecarlo (regular/salad), recommended for greenhouse only
- Double Rich (regular/salad), resistant to cracking and sunburn
- Louisiana Pink (regular/salad), good for humid conditions
- Ozark Pink (large regular/salad), good for humid conditions
- Caribe (large regular/salad), heat tolerant
- Sioux (regular/salad), heat tolerant
- Thessaloniki (regular/salad), resistant to sunburn
- Heinz 1350 (regular/salad), drought tolerant
- Purple Calabash (purple beef), drought tolerant
