

FAMILY FRUIT TREES



Do you like apples but worry that you don't have space to grow them? We have the answer to your problem, in the form of a 'family apple tree'. Apples usually need another apple tree of a different variety with which to pollinate, but with a 'family' apple tree, you will have 3 different varieties grafted onto one single tree, so you only need space for one tree. They can be grown in large pots or planted directly into the ground. If pot grown, they will likely stay less than 8ft tall. If planted in the ground they will grow a bit bigger, but it is easy to prune them so they stay at the size you want.

The tree shown below has been growing for around 35 years in Sussex, and has over 250 varieties grafted onto one tree, so that gardener really is an apple enthusiast!
