

BLUEBERRIES

By carefully selecting blueberry varieties, you can ensure a harvest over a longer period. The earliest varieties ripen from late June, and the latest varieties are harvested into September. By planting several varieties together you not only increase the crop by improving cross-pollination, but by selecting different seasons, you can enjoy fresh blueberries for longer.

Please bear in mind that these harvest times can be greatly influenced by the weather, ie an early spring will an earlier harvest, and likewise a period of poor weather or drought can delay fruit development.
