

# CAULIFLOWERS



- We grow the variety 'All Year Round', and as the name suggests, it can be sown and harvested throughout the year. It is a smaller sized variety, and also extremely easy to grow.
- As with any brassica, it can be susceptible to whitefly and butterfly problems in the warmer months, and bird damage during the colder months, so it may be best to protect your crop with fine netting.
- Spacing for cauliflowers depends on how big you plan on letting them grow, and also where you are growing them. If you grow in raised beds then you can plant them closer together, maybe 18" apart, but in open ground and for bigger cauliflowers, allow 24-30" between plants.
