

PANSY SWISS GIANT MIX



These pansies are half-hardy annuals, flowering May to October. Their blooms are larger than most other pansies, although the plants only reach 20cm tall, so they can be used in hanging baskets as well as flower borders. They like a well-drained soil, in full sun or partly in the shade. The flowers are edible.

TAGETES GEM MIXES



Tagetes grow to around 25cm tall, perfect for the front of the borders. They are highly aromatic, and when inter-planted with tomatoes, they help to ward off white-fly and bring pollinators into your greenhouse. They like free-draining soil in sunny positions, and will benefit from dead-heading to prolong flowering. Red, orange, yellow and mixed packs.

PETUNIA TRAILING BALCONY MIX



These petunias are a wide mix of single, bi-coloured and veined blooms. The plants are vigorous and will branch to 40cm, perfect for baskets, pots and borders. They prefer a well-drained soil in a sunny position, and are easy to grow. Regular dead-heading will prolong the flowering season.

ZINNIA PEPPERMINT STICK



These zinnias grow to around 60cm tall, producing bushy plants. The flowers are creamy yellow with unusual stripes and speckles, with no two flowers the same. They prefer a rich soil in full sun, but will tolerate some shade. They work well as cut flowers, and regular dead-heading will prolong the flowering season.
