

# BRUGMANSIA



- Brugmansias are also known as 'Angel Trumpets', and are part of the nightshade family.
- They will grow to become tropical shrubs or small trees, with large trumpet-shaped scented flowers. The flowers can be up to 30cm long, and may be single, doubles, or multi-later flowers (this will be marked on the plant labels).
- The plants originate from South America, and are not fully hardy in the UK. They are best grown in pots, enabling them to be moved to a frost-free location overwinter, preferably over 7C. The plants will usually go dormant during the winter months.
- Brugmansias are hungry and thirsty plants. They will need a high quality compost like John Innes 3, and dislike being waterlogged or allowed to dry out during the growing season. The plants will usually go dormant during the winter months.
- All parts of the plant are poisonous and the sap can be an irritant so wear gloves when pruning.
