Mixed lettuces

There are several options for how you can use our lettuce and salad packs:

You can plant them in clumps and not worry about thinning them out. If you do this, we recommend around 20 to 30cm between each clump to allow them to bush out, and then pick the leaves when they get to the size you want.

You can prick out and re-plant the lettuces individually, giving you an even bigger crop, but this is more fiddly.


Or if that seems like too much effort, you can keep the cell-packs in a shallow saucer of water and just pick or cut what you need, but take care not to cut too low down on the plants or you will remove the growing tips and they won't resprout.
